

## CAEP ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURE 4

### CAEP Accountability Measure 4: Ability of completers to be hired in the area of licensure.

#### **Employment Milestones: Professional Teaching Experience**

2023 EPP graduates reported a 77% employment rate across all programs. 15% of graduates are unemployed and looking, while 8% are unemployed and not looking. These data are disaggregated by program and summarized in Table 3.1.

Table 3.2 (below) shows ECSE, CSE, and CE completers currently employed and their employment setting. The currently employment data shows that out of 20 employed completers, 10 (50%) are working at public schools in New York City. A total of 8 (40%) are employed in another educational setting (e.g., private, charter, or early intervention / daycare). A total of 2 (10%) employed completers reported working in an area outside of education. These data are disaggregated by program and summarized in Table 3.2.
