For too many Latine peoples those foundations have been shaky, at best. Brutal colonialism & cultural erasure have conspired to eradicate facets of our indigenous history/heritage - embedding self-hatred into the very fabric of our societies and dividing us, physically/spiritually, with imaginary borders/boundaries that did not exist in the time of our ancestors.

Despite these efforts, indigenous aspects of our identity have persisted in our foods, arts, music, medicinal practices, languages and myths, gender role assignations, even our resource management styles. This one-day interdisciplinary symposium calls upon all members of our Latine community to reconnect with this heritage and unpack the myriad ways we may have consciously or unconsciously colluded with our cultural erasure, so we may begin the journey toward decolonization and liberation.
